It should mention the increased awareness and efforts of financial service providers, regulatory agencies, and the Financial Transaction Reports and Analysis Center (PPATK) in implementing the reporting obligations and conducting analysis activities.
- 2. The study should cite recent literature to support the argument that corruption is a result of weak social control and emphasizes the role of social control in defining and deterring deviant behavior.
- 3. The methodology section briefly describes the research design and approach used in the study. It should also state the process and method of the data collection. How was the data analysis conducted?
- 4. The discussion should provide an overview of Law Number 31 of 1999 and Law Number 20 of 2001, which outline regulations regarding community participation in preventing and eradicating corruption.
